COVID 19 SITUATION IN THE PHILIPPINES

- **COVID-19 Dedicated Beds**

- The Philippines is dedicating 38% of its licensed beds for COVID-19 care (53% of all public beds; 25% of all private beds)

- **HCUR Trends.** The Philippines is at low risk (51%). A decreasing trend for the overall utilization rate of COVID beds in the country is observed.

- **ICU Utilization.** The whole Philippines (66%) is at moderate risk of ICU utilization.

COVID 19 SITUATION IN THE PHILIPPINES

- **COVID 19 Medicines**

- Across all regions, there is shortage of Tocilizumab, however increasing availability of Remdesivir, Favipiravir and Baricitinib across all regions.
- Molnupiravir and Ronapreve are in the process of being available

- **Oxygen Supply**

- There is excess liquid oxygen supply in the island groups of Luzon and Visayas and gap in liquid oxygen in Mindanao
- Atleast _ % of reporting health facilities in 4 regions report of oxygen shortage in the past 24 hours

- **COVID 19 Equipment**

- A total of 1242 mechanical ventilators, 707 BIPAP Machines and 293 High Flow Nasal Cannula have been delivered to Health Facilities Nationwide

- **Ramping up Hospital Capacity**

- Total of Additional Health Human Resource Hired through Emergency Hiring- 9,863 (75 Specialists, 499 General Practitioners, 4,169 Nurses, 1,229 Medical Technologist...)
- Additional 22 Modular Hospital Units totaling to additional 466 Isolation/Critical Care Beds

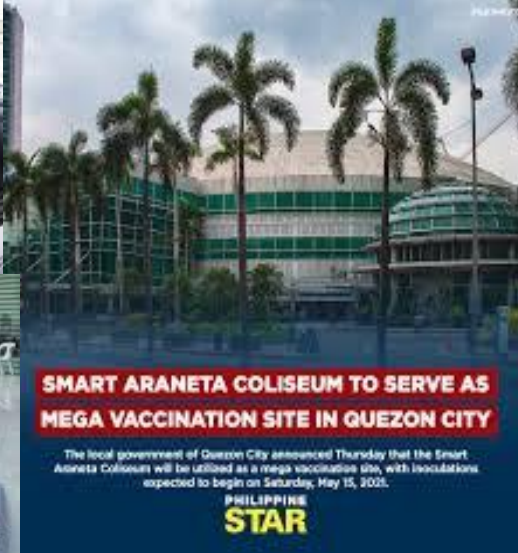
