COVID-19 Dedicated Beds

- The Philippines is dedicating 38% of its licensed beds for COVID-19 care (53% of all public beds; 25% of all private beds)
- HCUR Trends. The Philippines is at low risk (51%). A decreasing trend for the overall utilization rate of COVID beds in the country is observed.
- ICU Utilization. The whole Philippines (66%) is at moderate risk of ICU utilization.

COVID 19 SITUATION IN THE PHILIPPINES

COVID 19 Medicines

- Across all regions, there is shortage of Tocilizumab, however increasing availability of Remdesivir, Favipiravir and Baricitinib across all regions.
- Molnupiravir and Ronapreve are in the process of being available

• Oxygen Supply

- There is excess liquid oxygen supply in the island groups of Luzon and Visayas and gap in liquid oxygen in Mindanao
- Atleast _ % of reporting health facilities in 4 regions report of oxygen shortage in the past 24 hours


